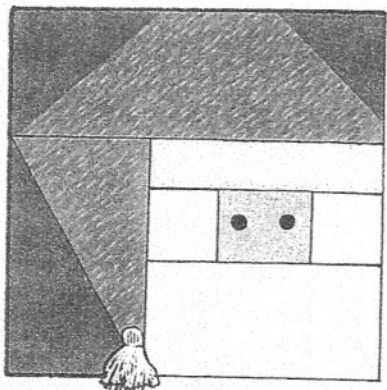


Santa

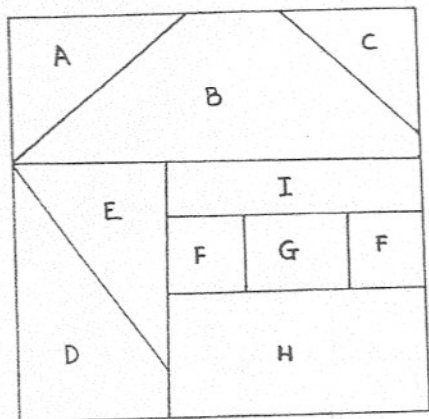
December Block of the Month



This jolly Santa Block is quick and fun to make. Embellishments make him spring to life. The pattern is from Jodie Davis' web site.

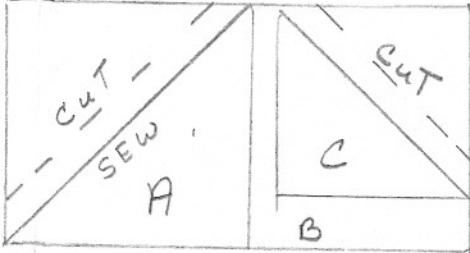
Color: Beard and Hat trim – White or near white
Face - Peach, pale pink, or a pale beige
Hat – Bright Red
Background – Navy or Dark Forest

Embellishments – 2 Black buttons for eyes and white yarn for hat tassel



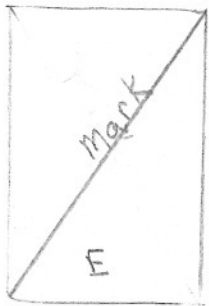
Cut;

- A – 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" Background
- B – 5 1/2" x 12 1/2" Red
- C – 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Background
- D – 5" x 7 1/2" Background
- E – 5" x 7 1/2" Red
- F – (2) 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" White
- G – 2 3/4" x 3 1/2" Peach
- H – 4" x 8" White
- I – 1 3/4" x 8" White



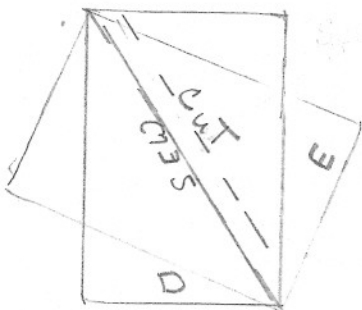
Place A fabric over B and sew diagonally corner to corner
Trim away the outer corner, flip up and press.

Repeat with piece C in the upper right corner of B
Check illustration for placement

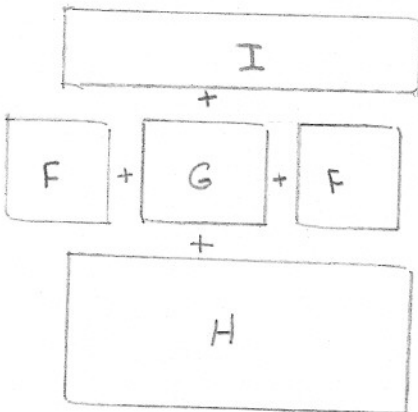


WRONG
Side of
Fabric

Mark fabric E red on the diagonal from top right hand corner
To the bottom left hand corner (mark wrong side of fabric)

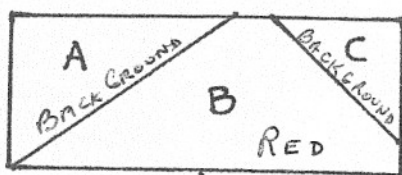


Place E red fabric over background D fabric and sew
On pencil line, from corner to corner. Trim, flip, and press.

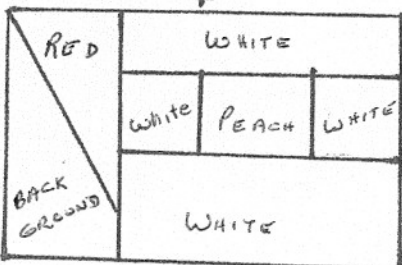


Sew F to G to F
Press toward G
Add white H beard to bottom

Add White I to top of f-g-f piece



Sew d/e block to the left side of the face block



Sew the A/B/C unit to the top of the face hat unit.

Now embellish it.
