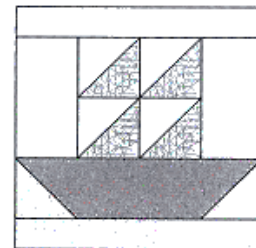
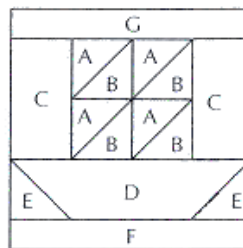


## Sail Away

June 2008

**Sky** *light blue or sky fabric*  
**Water** *dark blue on blue print*  
**Boat** *golden brown print*  
**Sails** *lighter yellow print*

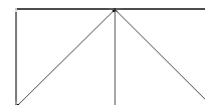


### Cutting

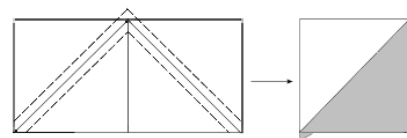
- From the fabric for A, cut 1 rectangle  $3 \frac{7}{8}'' \times 7 \frac{3}{4}''$ .
- From the fabric for B, cut 1 rectangle  $3 \frac{7}{8}'' \times 7 \frac{3}{4}''$ .
- From the fabric for C, cut 2 rectangles, each  $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 6 \frac{1}{2}''$ .
- From the fabric for D, cut 1 rectangle,  $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 13 \frac{1}{4}''$ .
- From the fabric for E, cut 2 squares,  $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}''$ . Draw diagonal line on each.
- From the fabric for F, cut 1 rectangle,  $2'' \times 12 \frac{1}{2}''$ .
- From the fabric for G, cut 1 rectangle,  $2'' \times 12 \frac{1}{2}''$ .

### Piecing

1. Draw a grid on the wrong side of rectangle A. The grid will have 2 squares, each  $3 \frac{7}{8}'' \times 3 \frac{7}{8}''$ . Draw 1 diagonal line in each square.



2. With right sides facing, stitch rectangles A and B together on each side of the diagonal lines. Cut apart to make 4 half-square triangle units, each  $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}''$ . Press toward triangle B. Trim the seam-allowance tips.



3. Stitch the 4 half-square triangle units together as shown to make 2 rectangles. Press. Stitch the rectangles together to make a  $6 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 6 \frac{1}{2}''$  square (sails).



4. Sew a rectangle C to opposite sides of the sails. Press toward rectangle C.



5. Stitch a square E, right sides together, on the diagonal line marked, to each end of rectangle D. Trim seam underneath and press E down.



6. Sew the hull to the sails and press toward hull. Sew rectangles F and G in place as shown above. Press towards rectangles F and G.
