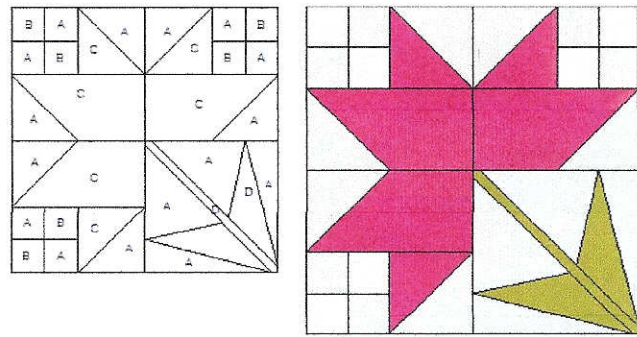


# TULIP BLOCK



## Cutting

- A - Background - Cream, Light Beige (6) 2" squares and (6) 3 7/8" squares
- B - Background - Lighter than A (6) 2" squares
- C - Flower Fabric - Color of your choice (6) 3 7/8" squares and (3) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
- D - Stem and Leaves - Green scraps (paper pieced)

## Sewing

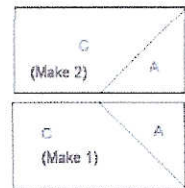
Make (3) four patch units using 2" squares of backgrounds A and B



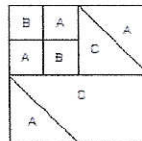
Make (3) half square triangles using 3 7/8" squares of background A and flower fabric C



On the back of the 3 remaining background A squares, draw a diagonal line corner to corner. Place these square, right sides together, over the 3 flower fabric C rectangles. Sew on the diagonal and press the background fabric to the corner. Trim the excess fabric from underneath. *Note: One of these units is sewn on the opposite diagonal!*



Assemble these units to make (3) 6 1/2" squares as shown.



Paper piece stem unit (pattern attached) using background A and green D. This makes a 6 1/2" unfinished square.

Assemble block as shown with the four units you have just made.
