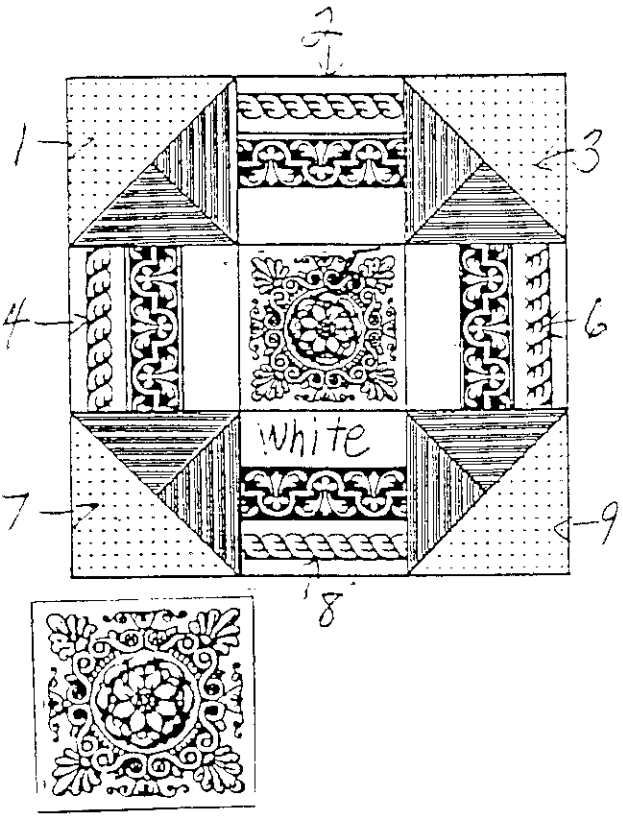

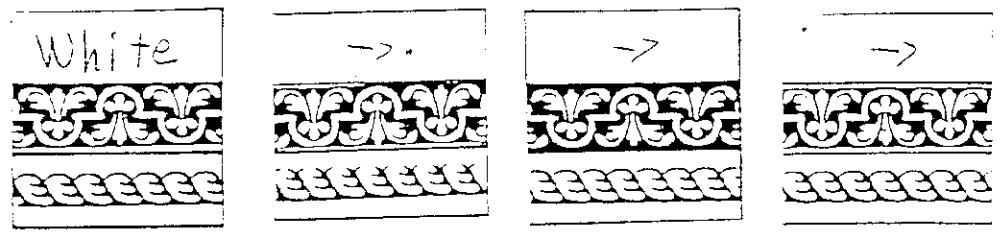

This square is a great one to use some of those border prints we have around. If you don't have any, regular prints will work too.



1. cut one 4 1/2" square for the center. The fabric used here can be repeated in another square if you like. This is center- block 5
2. This is for squares 2-4-6-8 You will strip piece a 19" long piece to be trimmed to make four 4 1/2" squares:
  - a) cut one 1 1/2" x 19" piece of white on white fabric
  - b) cut one 2" x 19" border print or regular print. Sew to white fabric
  - c) cut one 2 x 19" coordinating fabric. Sew to the border print.
  - d) cut four - 4 1/2" squares from the pieced 19" strip.



3. corner squares: (squares 1-3-7-9)
  - A. cut two 4 7/8" squares in half to make 4 triangles. It is indicated by polka dots in the picture.
  - B. striped fabric if possible: cut 2 - 5 1/2" squares in half, to make 4 triangles, then in half again to make 8 triangles. Position the stripes so they are at right angles to each other.
