✂ Fabric Selection:

Color 1 – yellow with a small print

Color 2 – green

Color 3 - medium blue print

Color 4 – medium/light blue print

of colors/prints

Cutting Directions: (Label your piles of cut pieces)

Color 1A – cut four 2-½ inch by 4 ½ inch rectangles

Color 1B – cut twelve 2 ½ inch squares

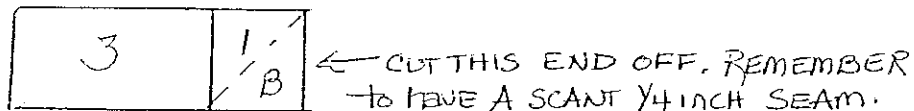
Color 2 – cut four 2 ½ inch squares

Color 3 – cut four 2-½ inch by 4 ½ inch rectangles

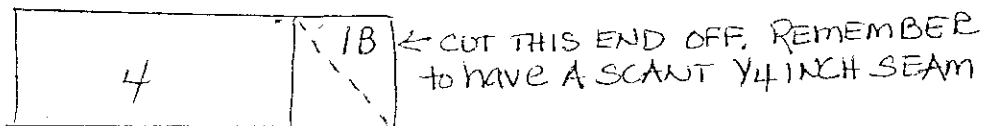
Color 4 – cut four 2 ½ inch by 6 ½ inch rectangles

Sewing Directions:

On the wrong side of all squares (color 1B), draw a diagonal line. Right sides together, place one color 1B square at the right end of one color 3 rectangle. Sew directly on top of marked line: cut away excess fabric. Note the direction of the drawn line in the diagram below. Make four.

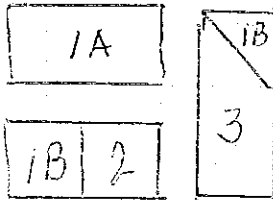


With right sides together, now sew a color 1B square to the right end of a color 4 rectangle. Please note the direction of the drawn line below. Sew directly on top of the marked line. Cut away excess fabric. MAKE FOUR.

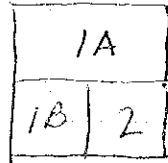

PIECES

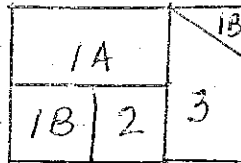


STEP 1



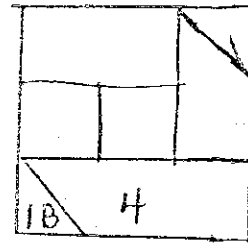
SEW 1A
