Block ~~One~~ #2

Patriotic Pinwheel
from 2004/2005

- ✂ **Fabrics:** *print*
Light blue or light solid for blocks A1 & B1
Red print for blocks A2
Medium/dark blue print for block B2
White background star, flag, etc print for center square

*Avoid red-white blue
use: various scrappy
fabrics with off white
background/ beige*

Directions:

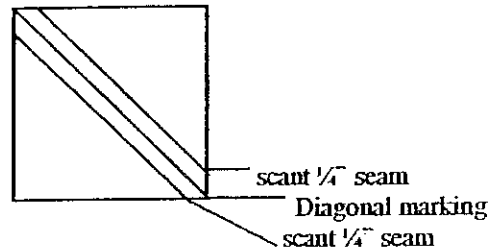
Cut four—4 7/8" squares from the light blue

Cut two—4 7/8" squares each from the

- Red print and
- Medium/dark blue print

Pair up the light blue squares with the red and dark blue squares, placing right sides together. Using a fine line pen, mark the diagonal on the wrong side and sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the diagonal. Cut apart on the diagonal line. This makes 4 sets of the A1/A2 squares and 4 sets of the B1/B2 squares. Press seams to the darker color.

Cut one 4 1/2" square from the white background patriotic print.



Assemble all the blocks as per the diagram below. Sew the blocks in rows either across or down and then sew the rows together. Take some care in butting the seams when possible.
