

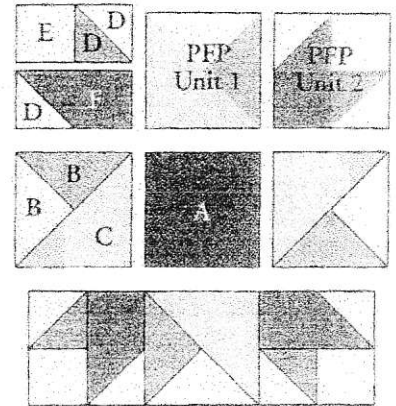
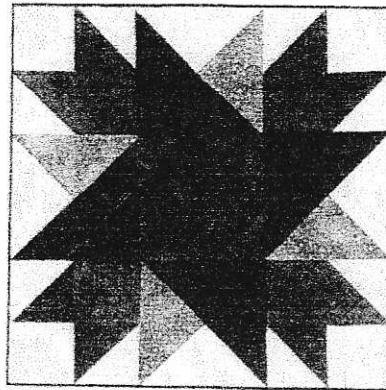

Sunflower

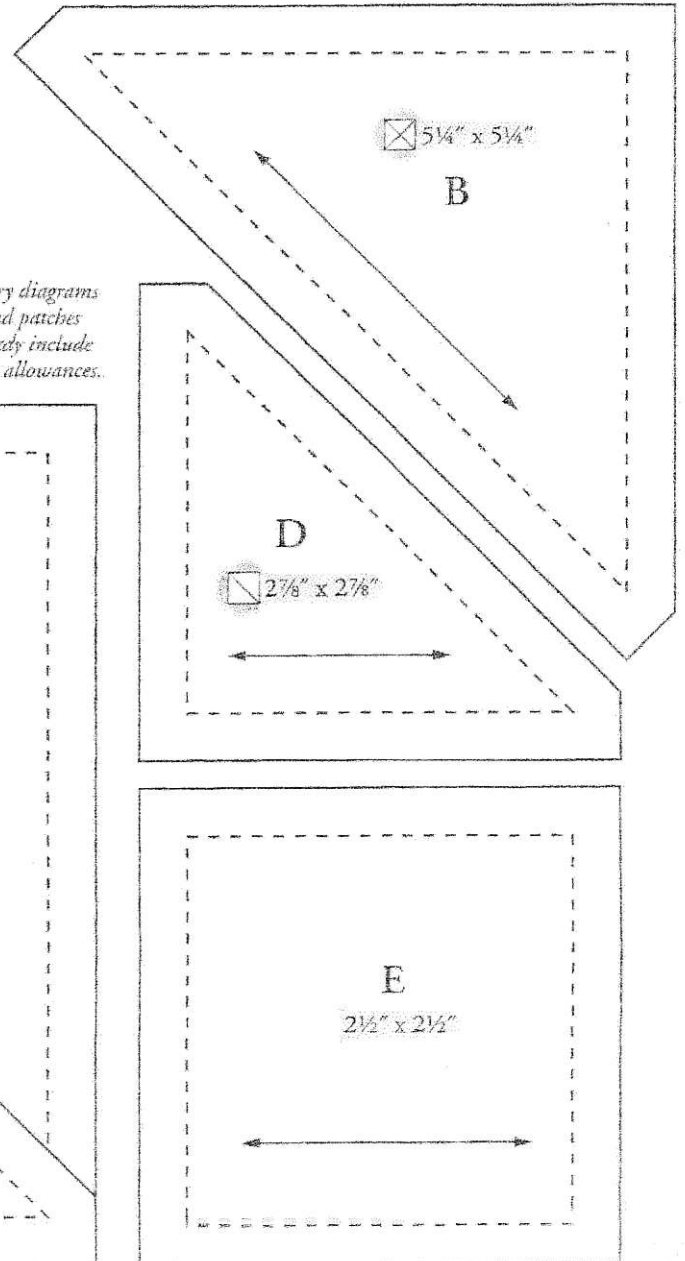
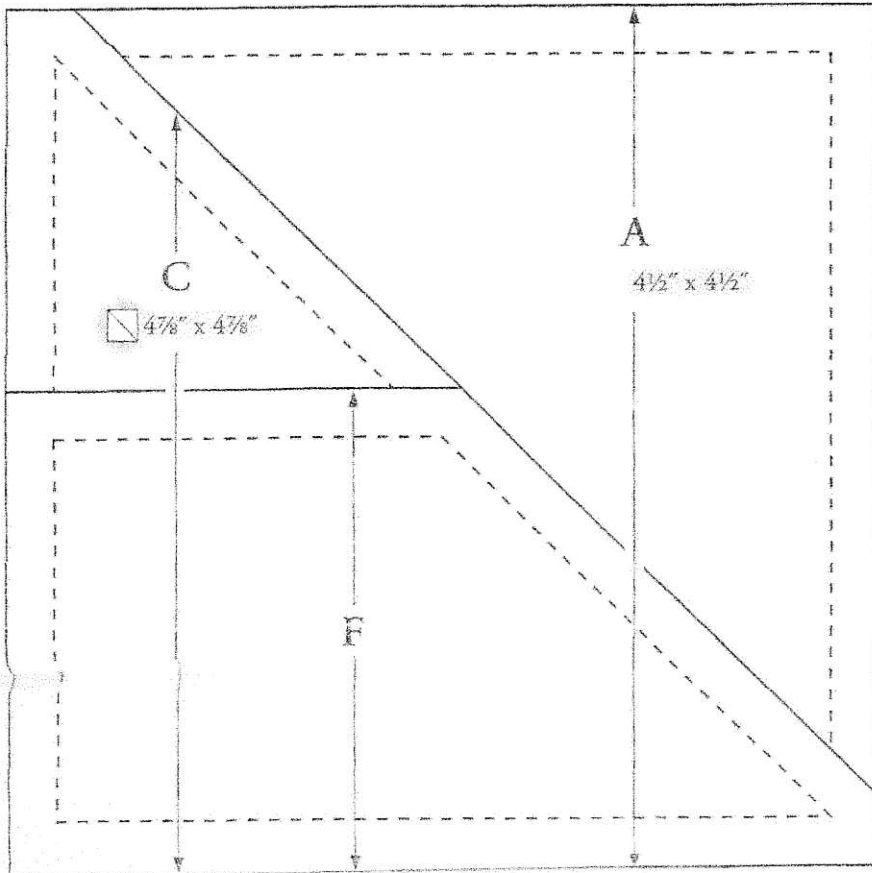
12" Block

Whether you use the colors typical of a flower or a dramatic color scheme, this block blossoms with possibilities. Notice that the different value placement accentuates different parts of the design. Because of the many bias edges, first lightly starch your fabric before cutting patches.



BLOCK PIECING

Rotary diagrams and patches already include seam allowances.



November – Sunflower Cutting Directions

Color #1 – Dark (brown)

A Cut 1 4 ½" X 4 ½" For Center

Color #2 – Light medium (light gold)

B Cut 1 5 ¼" X 5 ¼" Cut in ¼'s diagonally = 4 pcs

Color #3 – Dark Medium (light brown)

C Cut 2 4 7/8" X 4 7/8" Cut in ½ diagonally = 4 pcs

Color #4 – Dark Medium (dark gold)

D Cut 2 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" Cut in ½ diagonally = 4 pcs

Color #5 – Light (beige)

E Cut 4 2 ½" X 2 ½" Do NOT cut again

Cut 2 2 ½" X 2 ½" Cut in ½ diagonally = 4 pcs

Cut 1 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" Cut in ¼'s diagonally = 4 pcs

Cut 2 2 7/8" X 2 7/8" Cut in ½ diagonally = 4 pcs

Color #6 – Dark Medium (rust)

F Cut 4 2 ½" X 4 ½" Trim according to template

This block contains 33 pieces and 6 colors create movement and interest.
