Spring Flying Geese - 12 1/2"

Color A - Cream background: 16 x 3 1/2" squares

Color B - 2 different Medium/light yellow-green fabrics:

cut 1 x (3 ½" x 6 ½") rectangle from each fabric

Color C - 6 different fabrics in Spring colors (pinks, yellows, purples)

cut 1 x (3 ½" x 6 ½") rectangle from each fabric

- 1) Cut out all the fabric squares and rectangles
- 2) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the 16 cream squares. This is a sewing line.
- 3) Place a marked square on top of one end of a rectangle right sides together and stitch on the line. Trim to a ¼" seam, press seam open. Repeat on the opposite side of the rectangle using a second cream square. Sew, trim, and press seam open to make one flying geese unit. Repeat with remaining rectangles and cream squares to make 6 Spring colors flying geese units and 2 yellow/green flying geese units.
- 4) Randomly arrange flying geese units in two columns of 4 flying geese units each. Each column should have 1 green flying geese unit and 3 Spring colors flying geese units all "flying in the same direction" but not in the same order. Sew together with ½" seam allowance. Press seams.
- 5) Pin and sew the two flying geese columns, reversing one column so that the flying geese units are going in opposite directions. Press
