
Paper Pinwheels


Color A: Yellow-Green

- (4) 3 1/2" squares
- (2) 3 7/8" squares

Color B: White or White on White


- (8) 3 1/2" squares
- (2) 3 7/8" squares





Stack one Color A and Color B 3-7/8" square right sides together with all edges aligned. On the back of the top square lightly mark a line on the diagonal. Sew 1/4" above and below the marked diagonal. Cut apart on the marked diagonal between the rows of stitching. This will give you two half squares. Press seams

towards darker fabrics. This should measure as a 3-1/2" square. Repeat with the remaining Color A and Color B 3 7/8" squares.



Now just piece the block by sewing together four rows as shown at left using the units we just made. Press seams in alternating directions by row to keep seams flat.
