## Coral and Floral



Color 1 - Coral Four 3-1/2" squares

Two 2-5/8" squares

One 2" x 26" strip

Color 2 - Floral Two 2-5/8" squares

Color 3 - White One 2" x 26" strip

Two 3-7/8" squares and then cut again on the diagonal to make four triangles

- 1. Sew the Color 1 and Color 3  $2" \times 26"$  strips together along one long edge, right sides together and all edges aligned, using a 1/4" seam. Press seam allowance towards the darker fabric, and then cut apart at 6-1/2" intervals.
- 2. Sew each Color 1 2-5/8" square to a Color 2 2-5/8" square. Join these units to make the center four patch.
- 3. Sew a Color 3 triangle to one side of the four patch, using a 1/4" seam. Press seam allowance towards the center square. Add another triangle to the opposing side, again pressing towards the inner square. Now add the other two triangles to the remaining two sides of the center square, this time pressing the seams towards the triangles.
- 4. Now you can join the units to make the block! First make rows, then sew the rows together, and be sure to alternate pressing directions with each addition.
