



White	Three 4" squares
Light blue	Three 4" squares One 3" square Three 3-1/2" squares Two 2-1/2" squares One 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle One 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle
Brown	One 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle
Dark blue	One 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle
Red (for flag)	One 3" square

1-Sail Half-square triangles: Stack the White 4" square and Lt. blue 4" square, right sides together. On the back of the top square, mark a diagonal line and stitch a scant 1/4" above and below the marked diagonal. Cut apart on the marked line and press seam towards the blue fabric. Trim unit to measure 3-1/2". Repeat to make a total of 6 half-square units (You will use 5 and have one unit left over).

2-Flag half-square triangle: Using your flag fabric 3" square and Lt blue 3" square, follow steps in #1. Trim unit to measure 2-1/2". You will have one unit left over.

3-Hull unit: Stack Lt blue 2-1/2" square on upper right corner of brown 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle, right sides together. On the back of the top square, mark a diagonal line and stitch on marked line. Trim off excess seam allowance. Press seam allowance toward brown rectangle. Repeat for upper left corner of brown rectangle.



4-Using the block diagram as a guide, assemble units into rows. Row 1 – Lt blue 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangle + flag half-square triangle + Lt blue 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Row 2 – Lt blue 3-1/2" square + two Sail half-square triangles + Lt blue 3-1/2" square. Row 3 – Three Sail half-square triangles + Lt blue 3-1/2" square. Row 4 – Hull unit. Row 5 – Dk blue 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle. Press seam allowances in alternating directions by row.

5- Sew rows together to complete the block. The block should be 12-1/2" square.
