


MAY 2018 BOM



White

Two 5-1/2" squares
One 2-1/2" x 22" strip
One 2-1/2" x 6" strip

Light green

One 2-1/2" x 6" strip
Two 5-1/2" squares

Blue

One 2-1/2" x 22" strip

EBB TIDE

1-Half-square triangle units: Stack the white 5-1/2" and Light green 5-1/2" squares, right sides together. On the back of the top square, mark a diagonal line and stitch a scant 1/4" above and below the marked diagonal. Cut apart on the marked line and press seam towards the green fabric. Trim unit to measure 4-1/2". Repeat to make a total of 4 half-square triangles.

2-Four patch units: Sew the blue and white 2-1/2" x 22" strips together along the long side. Press seam allowance towards the blue fabric. Cut the pieced strip into eight 2-1/2" slices (you will have some left over). Sew the white and Lt. green 2-1/2" x 6" strips together along the long side. Press seam allowance towards the green fabric. Cut the pieced strip into two 2-1/2" slices (you will have some left over). Using the block diagram as a guide, sew the 2-1/2" slices into 4-patch blocks (these will measure 4-1/2" square). Press seam allowances.

3-Sew row 1 and 3: Blue/green 4-patch + half-square triangle + blue/blue 4-patch. Sew row 2: Half-square triangle + blue/blue 4-patch + half-square triangle. Press seams in alternating directions.

4- Sew rows together. Press seams in one direction. The block is complete and should measure 12-1/2" square.
