The Clamshell Quilt Guild 2020 Raffle Quilt patterns are from the Center Medallion Mariner Compass in Ann S. Lainhart's book "Fussy Cut Mariner's Compass." Ann Lainhart will send a signed copy of her book for the winner.

The sailboats and pinwheels were designed by Glenna Hailey, using her pattern "Sail Away."

The corner Mariner Compass block designs came from Sharlene Jorgenson's book: "Quilting from the Heartland"

The lobster pattern is from "Maine Course." It was

machine pieced and machine appliqued by members of the Raffle Quilt Committee and lovingly and meticulously machine Long Arm quilted by Debbie Loeser.

The Quilt has forty sailboat bocks, one 18 inch center mariner's compass, four 12 inch outer corner compasses, one hundred twenty 3 inch pinwheels, and eight 12 inch x 16 inch lobsters. It has four long arm quilted lighthouses, Northeast and Southwest direction signs, two sailboat motifs, two clamshell motifs and various waves and pearl motifs.

All fabrics used for the quilt top except the white came from member's stashes. Backing fabrics are from members' stashes also, and the back piecing includes ten more sailboats and mariner's compasses.
