- 6. Design may be:
 - a. An imaginary "travel poster" of a place in your imagination!
 - b. A real place you've never been but hope to see someday!
 - c. A documentary of a place you've traveled to and would like to represent in fabric!
 - d. An original fabric interpretation of a travel poster you've admired
 - e. The possibilities are endless...A to Z... African or Asian fabrics, State flowers, State blocks, State star blocks, travel photos to fabric, country & state flags, , Australian fabrics, Bali's, Zoo fabrics...etc. Have fun with it!!!!
- 7. Please do not violate any copyright laws.
- 8. An entry form must accompany all entries (see below). You must be a member to participate.
- 9. Your name cannot appear on the front of the quilt (to ensure judging is fair and unbiased).
