Steps to the Altar



Color 1 light purple: one 2-1/2" square Color 2 light blue: one 2-1/2" x 8" strip Color 3 medium purple: one 2-1/2" x 13" strip Color 4 dark purple: one 4-1/2" square and one 5" square Color 5 cream: 2-1/2" x 21"strip, one 3" square, one 4-1/2"x 13-1/2 strip

Cut color 2 blue 2-1/2" strip into 3 2-1/2" squares Cut color 3 medium purple strip into 5 2-1/2" squares Cut color 5 beige 2-1/2"x 21" strip into 8 2-1/2 squares Cut color 4 dark purple 5" square on diagonal. Use only 1 triangle Cut color 5 cream 3" square on diagonal to made 2 half square triangles Cut color 5 cream 4-1/2" x 13-1/2"strip into 2 4-1/2 x 6-1/2 rectangles



Piece the top row of block by sewing together 2-1/2 squares lt purple/ cream/ lt blue/ cream/ med purple/ cream with scant 1/4" seams Make one 6 square unit with 2-1/2 squares: cream/blue lt blue/cream cream/med purple


Make two 2 square units with 2-1/2 squares: cream/ med purple


Piece the blocks middle unit: sew color 5 cream half square triangle to bottom of last color 3 med purple small square. Add the other color 5 beige triangle to right of small square.


Sew this unit to color 4 dark purple half square triangle and to the top of this add one of the cream/med purple square units

Piece middle row by sewing together the six square unit, the middle unit and color 5/beige rectangle

Sew last row of block by joining the last two square unit: cream/med purple and color 5/beige rectangle and color 4 dark/purple 4-1/2" square











Place the three rows to make the block, alternating pressing directions.
