





CENTIFOURS

COLOR 1 Dark Green
COLOR 2 Medium Green
COLOR 3 White


Color 1: One 1-1/2" x 12 1/2" strip AND two 1-1/2" x 32 1/2" stripes
Color 2: One 2-1/2" x 5" strip AND one 1-1/2" x 13 1/2" strip
Color 3: One 2-1/2" x 5" strip AND one 1-1/2" x 13 1/2" strip
AND two 1-1/2" x 12 1/2" strips AND one 1-1/2" x 32 1/2" strip



Cut Color 2 and Color 3 2-1/2"x 5" stripes into two 2-1/2" squares each.




Now sew a Color 2 and Color 3 1-1/2" x 13 1/2" strip right sides together along one long edge using a scant 1/4" seam. Press to dark side. Cut this into four 2-1/2" long sections and two 1-1/2" long sections...





Sew together two Color 3 and one Color 1 1-1/2" x 12 1/2" stripes as shown at left and cut into eight 1-1/2" sections

Sew together two Color 1 and one Color 3 1-1/2" x 32 1/2" stripes as shown. Cut this into four 6-1/2" sections and four 1-1/2" sections




Sew the two Color 2/Color 3 1-1/2" sections together to make one four patch



Now piece the block's center by laying out the small four patch we just made, the Color 2 and Color 3 squares, and the four Color 2/Color 3 2-1/2" sections. Sew these together...

**** Make the center block first and then piece the sides & top to fit around center****

**Time to piece the block! Lay out all units as shown.
Sew Color 1/Color 3 6-1/2" units to the sides of center unit.
Sew corner nine patch units to ends of remaining 6-1/2 units.
Add these to the top and bottom of the block.**



This makes a 12" block
